- 1. Jason Bond and I will begin with preseason maintenance at the park as weather permits.
- 2. Jason and I met with our forester, Will Jennings for a park walkthrough on Saturday February 26<sup>th</sup> and Saturday March 5<sup>th</sup> for this upcoming season's annual tree servicing. The focus of this season's project is on hazardous trees that are dead, dying, or diseased. Trees that are cut will be processed into 6' to 8' bolts to be reused as firewood for park patrons.
