Whereas, the abandon Lehigh valley railroad runs north to south through the town of Hector.

Whereas, railroad beds due to their relative flatness provide for an easily accessible recreational trail.

Whereas, Hector residents would be the primary users of a safe, beautiful, and enjoyable Trail which would provide unique opportunities for recreation and exercise.

Whereas, creating a pedestrian connection between the communities of the Valois, Hector, Burdett and onto Odessa would strengthen the town of Hector as a whole.

Whereas, a rail trail would help strengthen and expand Hector's Agro tourism Industry, which will increase the tax base and help to lighten the property tax burden on Hector residents.

Whereas, Hector will rely on the enormous generosity of landowners for donated Easements. Eminent domain will never be used.

Whereas, the creation and maintenance of the rail trail will be a grassroots Community-based effort, relying solely on volunteers and donated funds.

No Hector tax money would be used.

Now therefore be it resolved; The town of Hector will create the Hector rail trail and will hold the easements for such a trail.

Be it further resolved; The town of Hector will follow five guiding principles for the creation and continued use of the Hector rail trail.

- 1. The rail trail will only be built on Easement from willing property owners. No eminent domain will be used.
- 2. The rail trail will only be built using volunteers and donated funds. No Hector tax money will be used.
- 3. Workarounds / alternative routes will be needed in some areas.
- 4. Building the rail trail is a long-term project, patience will be required.
- 5. The rail trail will be maintained by volunteers and friends of Hector's Rail Trail. No Hector tax money will be used for this purpose.

2023 SECTION 284 AGREEMENT TO SPEND TOWN HIGHWAY FUNDS TOWN OF HECTOR / COUNTY OF SCHUYLER Approved 6/13/2023

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law; we agree that money levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS: The following sums, totaling **\$647,300.00** (all from **CHIPS** monies) shall be set aside to be expended for improvements upon **6.37 miles** of Town Highways:

- 1: Shuler Road: On the road commencing at Cayutaville road and leading 1.34 miles north toward pavement ends; there shall be expended not over the sum of \$24,000.00 (CHIPS) for oil and stone single course 20' wide.
- 2: Updyke Road: On the road commencing at State Route 227 and leading 1.20 miles east toward Black Road; there shall be expended not over the sum of \$22,000.00 (CHIPS) for oil and stone single course 20' wide.
- 3: Cass Road: On the road commencing at State Route 414 and leading 0.29 miles south toward Montour T/L; there shall be expended not over the sum of \$6,300.00 (CHIPS) for oil and stone single course 20' wide.
- 4: Satterly Hill Road: On the road commencing at turn around top of hill and leading 2.74 miles north toward Mathews Road; there shall be expended not over the sum of \$455,000.00 (CHIPS) for type 3 binder black top 20' wide by 3" depth.
- <u>5: Mathews Road:</u> On the road commencing at County Road 4 and leading 0.80 miles west toward Satterly Hill Road; there shall be expended not over the sum of \$140,000.00 (CHIPS) for type 3 binder black top 20' wide by 3" depth.

- Smith Park- Jeremey and I with the assistance from Zack replaced 3 more-yard hydrants and uncovered septic tank lid for north bathroom.

RE: Regulations of off-premise signs located along State Routes

Dear Sir or Madam:

The New York State Department of Transportation is required by the Federal Highway Administration (86 & 88 Highway Law & agreements with the Federal Government), in accordance with the Highway Beautification Law, to conduct an annual sign surveillance of certain roads that are eligible for federal aid. As the result of our annual sign surveillance, we must send several removal notices to the owner of every illegal sign found. This includes signs meant to be seen along certain State Routes, whether in the right-of-way or on private property.

Please refer any of your residents who would like to place an advertising sign that will be visible from State Routes to me at (607) 324-8572 or Laura.Lowe@dot.ny.gov.

If it appears that they will qualify for a permit, we will send them an application. With the completed application, we require that they send written confirmation from the municipality stating that a building permit either can be issued or that one is not required to ensure that the sign will meet all local regulations.

Please note that State Route 414, from Watkins Glen north to the Seneca County border is a Scenic Byway and new registered signs and not allowed to be permitted here.

We are sending this notice annually to all of the municipalities within our region that include any roads we control signing along. Please share this information with your Zoning/Code Enforcement Officers or any other personnel that it may apply to.
